1. I would like to see better clarification of the classifications
 - Re- entry or return to work
 - New graduates seeking registration
 - Current registered MRP who have indicated their scope of practice
 - Modality only registrants (MRI, US , CT limited for NM etc.)

This would make it clear to mainly older workers that it is not expected that they perform CT, MRI etc.

2. All MRP's should be asked to indicate if their scope of practice includes fluoroscopy, mobile radiography, theatre capability
3. When registering if MRP' s have changed their previously indicated scope they should do so.- it hard to remember what we did before
4. The following modules should be mandatory
 - as part of deteriorating patient management- BLS- (I think St John provides 2 yearly certification).
 - Hand hygiene- The Australian on line module
5. When the cultural awareness is more developed, then there MUST be a module(most people I think don't even know what they don't know
6. I would like to see inclusion to links for various state and national legislation ACTS, websites. (Drugs and poison, radiation, patient privacy, ethics, open disclosure, WHS)
