
# Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia Registrant data

Reporting period: 01 January 2021 to 31 March 2021



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#### Introduction

The role of the Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia (the Board) is to:

- register medical radiation practitioners and students
- develop standards, codes and guidelines for the medical radiation profession
- investigate notifications and complaints
- where necessary, conduct panel hearings and refer serious matters to Tribunal hearings
- oversee the assessment of overseas trained practitioners who wish to practise in Australia, and
- approve accreditation standards and accredited courses of study.

The Board's functions are supported by the <u>Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency</u> (Ahpra). For information about legislation governing our operations see <u>About Ahpra</u> at <u>www.ahpra.gov.au/About-Ahpra/What-We-Do/Legislation.aspx</u>.

The Board has analysed its registration data and produced a number of statistical breakdowns about registrants to share with the profession and community. The Board shares these breakdowns regularly.

Ahpra and the Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia established a short-term pandemic response sub-register for up to 12 months (or less if the pandemic subsides) to help with fast tracking the return to the workforce of experienced and qualified health practitioners. The pandemic response sub-register came into effect on 6 April 2020. Eligible Diagnostic Radiographers were added to the pandemic response sub-register on the 20 April 2020. 


