- Majority of staff vote in favour of our new Enterprise Agreement 2022-2025
- Completion of joint funding review for the Queensland OHO.

The Committee welcomed recently appointed Western Australia State Manager Ms Jodie Holbrook who provided the Committee with the context of the regulatory health workforce current landscape and future challenges in Western Australia.
