Like their urban counterparts, remote Australians deserve easy, affordable and timely access to the highest standard of primary health care.

It is well documented that remote Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, the remote poor and the remote aged, collectively record the lowest health status in the country. It is these same people who typically cannot afford trips to cities for specialist care, who do not have strong social supports available to sustain them when receiving treatment in the cities, and/or who experience major cultural stress from being separated from their rural/remote community.

There are considerable health benefits to offering as many advanced and procedural skilled services in the remote context as is safely possible. The Rural Generalist workforce is especially important to the healthcare of these people.

Recognition of Rural Generalist Medicine as a specialist qualification will ensure that remote Australians who have access to appropriate co-ordinated healthcare, can have confidence that the doctor in their healthcare team has the advanced skills and aptitudes to address their health care needs.

Added to that, the opportunity for general practitioners to be proceduralists is highly valued and is important to attracting and retaining them in remote communities.

Remote Australians Matter supports all measures that will improve the health and wellbeing of all members of the Australia's remote communities.
